# Passwd Extension Upgrade Guide

We have improved the authentication flow in the Passwd extension, which now enables support for our upcoming Firefox extension as well as a mobile app we are working on. To ensure continued and expanded access, you need to take a quick action in your Google Cloud Platform (GCP).

## What You Need to Do

To complete this update you must be the Google Cloud Console administrator.

1. Sign in to [Google Cloud Console](#)
2. Select the passwd project.
3. Navigate to [API & Services > Credentials](#). Under "OAuth 2.0 Client IDs," locate the credentials associated with Passwd.

4. Click on it and add the new OAuth redirect URIs. In the Authorized redirect URIs section, add the following URLs:

1. Go to [IAM & Admin > IAM](#) in your Google Cloud Console.
2. Click "Add" and enter *install@passwd.team* as a new member.
3. Assign the "Editor" role (or a similar role that allows credential management).
4. Click "Save."
5. Let us know via Tidio chat that you've added us.

Once we receive your message, we'll take care of the necessary changes on your behalf.

By completing this step, you'll ensure seamless authentication in Chrome, Firefox, and our upcoming mobile app! 🚀
